- AVIATION COMMAND CENTER - ACC

ACC room

- Scif area off to right of ACC
↳ mini watch - manned by intel watch people from ACI

- The 2 people in charge of room sit on desks in front of room.

- FAA Tactical net → internal use for FAA entities (mainly FAA & security entities).

- Primary net → meant to engage outside agencies like CIA, FBI, etc.

- He says it seemed like Air Traffic took over the dais (front of room).

- Weibert says he passed information back and forth to folks on dais from Air Traffic.

Day of 9-11

- ch Cafeteria ^{2nd FL} having coffee - 8:45

- rec'd page from ACI - Watch _{3rd FL}

- He reported to ACI Watch on 3rd FL.

- Page told him to call ACI-Watch:

- He went to ^{Bob McLaughlin.} ACI - Claudio Manna and others had information that flt. attendant was stabbed and ~~the~~ hijackers may be in control of cockpit.

- Weichert and Bob Clarke went to 10th FL. to activate ACC.

- Bob McLaughlin went to alert Joe Fongine and other ACS security experts.

- He told Sharon Battle to stand up the ACC.

- He thinks Matt Hahn opened the ~~new~~ mini-SCIF on the 10th FL.

- they had just set up a computer system to track multiple events on a computer "log" format.

↓
* - These logs were kept on 9-11 by Primary net and Tactical net event recorders.

— Weickert says he told WOC - (Sharon Buttle) to activate the entire ACC room and not just the tactical NET.

— Pete Falcone took over the Tactical net position.

— He sits in the primary net position.

— When he arrived at the ACC, he saw aftermath of WTC-1 crash.

↓
— First thought - WTC-1 crash not related to hijacked plane.

— He then saw WTC-2 crash on T.V. (either live or replay)

— Had not heard about 2nd hijacked plane when he saw WTC-2 crash.

— He heard about second hijacked plane after WTC-2 crash.

— It took some time to sort out which A/C hit which bldg.

- no discussion about getting
military help when he arrived
At ACC. ^{he recalls}

- Somewhere ~~before~~ 9:20 A.M. -
Weskert got on the Primary
Net.

↳
- It took some time for other
parties to get on the line.

- 9:20 A.M. → approx time
Primary net was activated and
outside parties got on it.

- Protocol was for WOC officers
to notify ACC what parties
entered Primary Net.

- He ~~re~~ relies on WOC folks
to add appropriate parties
to the primary net. WOC
has a checklist for this.

- He recalls FBI, DoS,
WH Situation Room, DOD (for
a brief period of time).

- ACO sent someone TO FBI SIOC.
- That person took over the role of net monitor on Primary net for FBI.
- He thinks USSS was on the Primary net for a little while.
- ~~He~~ He recalls DOS, FBI, WH Sit Room (?), 'USSS' (?).
- He thinks NMCC is brought into Primary net just to monitor the net.
- He does not specifically recall NMCC joining the ~~net~~ Primary net.
- He does recall DoD briefly being on the Primary net.
- He recalls specifically trying to raise DoD on the Primary net to give them UAL 93 information.

- He recalls M. Belger in ACC
monitoring Primary net and
Tactical Net re: UAL 93.

- He did not get specific
information on UAL 93 on
the Primary net. → He
did not hear AT people on
his net.

- There was not much traffic
on his Primary net on
9/11. → He was giving
information on the P. net
and not ~~was~~ receiving
much information.

- He knew there was a 4th A/C
that AT people in front of
ACC were concerned about.

- DA Belger and A.T. folks
monitored UAL 93 until it
crashed in PA.

- No UAL 93 Update is coming
over the Primary net to Weikert.

- He overhears reports in room regarding UAL 93.
- He overheard some conversations about location of UAL 93 before it went down.
- There was a discussion in the room about whether DOD was on the line with anyone.
- Open question in the room about whether DOD was on the line. → He believes Mr. Belya tried to address this question.
- Mike Weikert calls out for DOD / military on his primary net and gets no response.
 - ↳
- He expected DOD to be on line but thought the Pentagon crash may have caused them to drop off the line.
- He vaguely recalls DOD being

on the Runway net briefly
before the Pentagon was hit.

— At 10:15 am — Pete Falcone
asks for military help on Tac net.

↳ This is probably re: Belzer's
request for DoD help on UAL 93

— He got the impression that
the military had already
scrambled planes to D.C. Area.

Heard about 2d hijack after 2d crash

no real discussion when he first
got up to 10th floor

on prime net after 2d strike

- he referred to big time of 0920
it took a while for the net to
activate
- 0920 = time bridge was
activated - normally they
would announce that someone
was added
- relies on WOC to do the check list
& to add people to the net
- recalls FBI, State, WHS ^{for} _{awhile}
NMCC on very briefly, CIA
sent a security person to FBI
SIOC, Karen Geric

He thought the ~~for~~ back to from
bottom to top
legs we had were WOC legs

log ACC activated 0858

- doesn't recall hearing that AA11 was still airborne

- does think SS was on for a little while

- NMCC brought in on in listening made re Spec Ops

on brief
trying to raise them for Penns crash, they weren't on anyone's net

Monte was in room at the time

- neither net on speaker phone

- room, little traffic on his net, most people dropped off
doesn't recall much traffic on that net that day

- Doesn't recall TSD being fed into TV - upper right corner
CNN was on

- He overheard conversations at the
diner around the time of
9/11

- NMCC/DOD was not on his
line

open Q "Does anybody have
contact w/ DOD right now?"

Perhaps Monte framing the Q.

CAC Problems

- Pentagon strike too DOD off net
- should have been redundant comms
- ~~IT~~ today, DEIC is established

- 3d floor would be where
ATCC would have come
in

- It was pretty clear to him
that AT was talking to
CC, separate line

- his critique - for ACC
it was a collateral duty
