interviewed at his residence. His wife, BEATRICE GUADAGNO was  
also present during the interview. Subsequent to being advised  
of the official identity of interviewers, and reason for their  
contact, J. GUADAGNO provided the following information:

J. GUADAGNO identified his son as RICHARD JERRY  
GUADAGNO RICHARD, who was a passenger aboard UNITED AIRLINES  
Flight 93 on September 11, 2001. He provided RICHARD's date of  
birth as September 26, 1962, and place of birth as Trenton, New  
Jersey.

RICHARD attended the FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING  
CENTER in Glynco, Georgia, and was employed as a National Park  
Ranger and Refuge Manager for U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE. He had  
recently been transferred from the State of Oregon to the  
HUMBOLDT BAY NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE, 1020 Ranch Road, Loleta,  
California 95551. His current address was 105 Westgate Drive,  
Eureka, California 95503. He also used an address of P.O. Box  
812, Loleta, California 95551-0612. His contact numbers were as  
follows: home - 707-269-0638; work - 707-733-5406 and cell -  
707-498-5406.

RICHARD was aboard Flight 93, returning to his  
residence, after visiting his family in New Jersey to help  
celebrate his grandmother's 100th birthday the weekend before.  
J. GUADAGNO had no knowledge of the method of payment used by  
RICHARD to purchase his airline ticket.

RICHARD had no military service, and J. GUADAGNO is  
unaware of any security clearances RICHARD might have held.

J. GUADAGNO's last contact with his son was upon  
dropping RICHARD at the Newark Airport for his flight on the  
morning of September 11, 2001. He had no unusual conversations  
with RICHARD, discussing among other things, when he and his wife  
would visit their son in California, and RICHARD's concern about

his father's safety during his return drive to Trenton in rush  
hour traffic.

RICHARD's luggage consisted of a large piece of

luggage, a carry on bag and a FARBERWARE COFFEE MAKER box containing clippings he took from plants in the GUADAGNO's back yard. J. GUADAGNO explained that each time his son moved to another residence, he took clippings from his parent's back yard to plant at his new home. Based upon past actions, J. ROTHENBERG believed that RICHARD would not check, but would attempt to carry on both of his bags and the box of plant clippings.

J. GUADAGNO requested that if any personal effects belonging to his son are recovered, they be returned to him. DNA samples have already been provided to the appropriate authorities.

JERRY and BEATRICE GUADAGNO were advised of the existence and general purpose of the Victim/Witness Assistance Program. They were provided a Victim/Witness Assistance Program brochure, as well as a business card, with the names of the interviewing agents.
