

11/20/03 Timeline re: Rebirth of AAL 11

① Call from ZBW Colin Scoggins to NEADS. Scoggins says AAL 11 is still airborne and headed ^{south} towards Washington D.C. Scoggins says Washington Center reported this information.

② Call from NEADS I.D. Section to ZDC regarding report AAL 11 airborne and headed south to Wash. D.C.
- ZDC advises NEADS that they believe AAL 11 was one of the planes that crashed into WTC.

③ 9:23 A.M. Call from NEADS. (Probably Steven Roundtree - recorded on ZNY Tape # 75, Position R86 oceanic at ZNY)
NEADS asks ZNY R86 for information regarding report that AAL 11 is still airborne and headed to D.C.
- R86 tells NEADS to call ZNY Watch Desk.
- NEADS says to have watch Desk call them because they can't seem to call out to ZNY Watch Desk.
