On 1/31/2001, ATTA purchased an Atlanta sectional chart from the flight school. On 03/22/2001, ATTA performed a solo flight. He was in the air for approximately one hour.

Investigative Efforts:

(LES) Mohamad Atta recently liquidated a stock account which has been open since 1998. Baltimore is seeking a search warrant.

(LES) FBI Baltimore (FBI BA) is continuing physical surveillance at residence to identify any information which would establish probable case for search and/or material witness warrants.



To date, a one-page listing of Arabic names and telephone numbers have been located on one of the hard drives. This information has been provided to FBI HQ and New York. Record checks of this information met with negative results.




