#### American Reaches Out With Care Teams

Upon notification of yesterday's terrorist attacks on its aircraft, American began mobilizing employees to assist families touched by the tragedy.

To date, American has sent more than 350 CARE team members to the departure and destination airports, and has local command centers established in these cities. These individuals, and more than 300 additional American employees staffing command centers and Family Assistance Centers in Fort Worth, Texas, are providing constant support and assistance to family members.

"We are horrified by these tragic events," said Donald J. Carty, American's chairman. "Our employees are working with these families to assist however we can."

The airline has also dispatched teams as active participants in the ongoing investigations and is cooperating fully with all governmental agencies.
